Monthly Networking Tip:

It's a Thursday morning and you've got an 8:30 am appointment with one of your clients. There's a light dusting of snow outside, but nothing to be concerned about. You're on time, but come to find out your car won't start. What do you do? Email the client and everyone who works with them to let them know that you won't be able to make the appointment? Call the client, explain your situation and reschedule? Probably the later, right? The reason for this is when a scheduling situation arises, it's important to contact the people most directly affected. Let's apply this to your membership; we know that absences happen! So, when you're suddenly unable to attend a meeting and need to 'take an absence', avoid emailing your entire chapter as it's unnecessary and usually hurts your reputation. Instead, email your Leadership Team to explain the situation, email that day's Featured Presenter to set up a 1-2-1 (you want to show them that what they had to teach you that day is important to you), and email any members you were scheduled to have a 1-2-1 with that day and explain your situation. We've all received chapter-wide emails explaining an absence, and they can be a real downer, so let's get rid of those!

I don't know about you, but I enjoy having friends and family visit at my house, and I see our meeting as an extension of inviting people into our home When I have company at my home, I always dust and clean before company arrives and greet them as a welcomed guest. I always feel that you want to set a great impression. Nothing is more important than the first impression. It truly is similar when we invite visitors to attend any of our BNI meetings.

Below is our recipe for success:

- Name badges on and visible for guests to see.
- Dressed professional representing our business and the customers that we are looking to attract.
- Warmly greeting all visitors and making them feel welcomed.
 (We are all visitor hosts)
- Ask the visitor what profession they represent. If it is not a seat conflict, tell them that you are really glad that they are here, as our chapter is looking for that classification to pass referrals.

- Review the meeting agenda with them so they are prepared when they are asked to introduce themselves.
- Introduce visitors to fellow members within their Contact Sphere.
- Make a point of sitting down next to a visitor in a meeting. Ask them, "Did you get to meet with some of the members? We have a great group of professionals in our chapter."
